<u>Holiday Inn Binghamton, 2 Hawley Street, Binghamton, NY 13901</u> – There are SEVERAL ways to locate the hotel. Directions are listed below, but feel free to 'Google Map' the directions to our contest venue:

<u>From the **North**</u>: At exit 4 South take ramp right for RT-7 South E towards Binghamton. Keep straight onto RT - 363 West. Turn right onto Washington Street. Turn left onto Hawley Street. Arrive at hotel.

<u>From the **South**</u>: From I-81 take exit 4 South. Take ramp right for Rt-7 South towards Binghamton. Keep straight onto RT-363 West. Turn right onto Washington Street. Turn left onto Hawley Street. Arrive at hotel.

<u>From the **East**</u>: At exit 4 South take ramp right for RT-7 South E towards Binghamton. Keep straight onto RT - 363 West. Turn right onto Washington Street. Turn left onto Hawley Street. Arrive at hotel.

<u>From the West</u>: At exit 72, take ramp right and follow signs for US-11 / Front Street. Turn right onto US-11 / Front Street. Turn left to stay on US-11 / Main Street. Turn right onto Hawley Street. Arrive at hotel.

### **GENERAL CONTEST INFORMATION**

• Each chorus will have an OPTIONAL **one hour** rehearsal room Saturday morning. *Room assignments will be sent as part of the schedule to each chorus.* Rehearsal times are by Order of Appearance:

\* 9-10AM - - Northern Blend, Crystal Chords, Harmony Falls, Liberty Belles & Chesapeake Harmony Chorus

\*10:05-11:05AM - - Heart of PA, NFCA, Bella Nova, Reading A Cappella Voices & Rochester Rhapsody

- Chorus Stage Awareness will be held on Saturday 9:30-10AM. Only <u>FIVE</u> members of each chorus may attend the viewing. No singing.
- Quartet Stage Awareness information will be sent separately to competing quartets.
- Evaluation times and locations will be announced at contest by the COJ.
- For SAFETY reasons, NO scooters will be allowed to go up the ramp onto the stage. We will have a wheelchair available to transfer into.
- For SAFETY reasons, NO ONE will be allowed around the back of the risers ON the stage. We don't want anyone tumbling off the back of the stage! Please keep this in mind when sorting out your props.
- Risers are six Wenger Tourmaster six-foot risers, with three steps and a back rail.
- There will be NO stage curtain. Each chorus package starts when the director signals the Emcee for the introduction. Quartet packages will begin when the Emcee introduces each quartet.
- <u>**REMINDER**</u> <u>**Chorus Photo Change**</u>: CHORUS photos will be taken on stage <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> <u>AFTER</u> your performance. After the chorus takes their applause, the director will return to a chorus position. The chorus then assumes a pose and the photos begin. Three photos will be taken. You will be able to tell by the flashes. The chorus has the option of changing poses between photos. [Quartet photos will still be in a separate room prior to the warm-up room.]
