



GENERAL CONTEST INFORMATION

CHORUS Info

- Chorus Rooms: Each chorus will have their own room to warm-up in. The rooms will be available from 10am until contest is finished. Rooms must be cleared out as soon as the contest ends as you may be in a different room for your eval.
- **Chorus Stage Awareness** will be held on Saturday morning 8:15 am to 9:00 am. Only <u>FIVE</u> members of each chorus may attend the viewing. No singing.
- **Risers** are six, six-foot risers with four steps and a back rail.

MASKS

- Masks should be 3-ply medical grade masks or higher. No cloth masks.
- Masks can be removed backstage and then replaced once you exit the stage area.
- Masks must be worn during evaluations.

CONTESTANT BRIEFING

• The briefing is Friday 1:00 pm in the convention center. Each quartet must attend, and each chorus must send a representative. Quartet stage awareness will immediately follow the briefing.

QUARTET STAGE AWARENESS

- Quartet stage awareness is at 1:30 pm (or immediately following the Briefing). We will be asking everyone to exit the ballroom immediately after the Briefing.
- Quartets will line up at the stage door (outside the ballroom) in order of appearance. Our stage manager (Linda Hilko) will call each quartet into the stage area. You will have 2 minutes on stage. You may sing or use your time however you would like. As soon as TIME is called, please exit stage left and leave the ballroom. You may bring a coach, who may enter the backstage area with your quartet and who will be directed out front.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Since we have **NO platform stage**, there will be bright green tape to show where the performance line is. Please stay in front of the line.
- <u>Reminder:</u> There will be NO stage curtain. Each chorus package starts when the director signals the Presenter for the introduction. Quartet packages begin when the Presenter introduces each quartet.
- Evaluation times and locations will be announced at contest by the ADM (Administrative Judge).

Ramada by Wyndham – Liverpool-Syracuse, NY Sunday, May 1, 2022

Classes are held in the Cotillion 1 and Cotillion 3 rooms on the Main Floor.

9:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m.

Class 1: **You Be the Judge** - with Joe Hunter (Certified Performance Judge), Kathy Greason (Certified Music Judge), and Jen Wheaton Forest (Certified Singing Judge). *Location: Cotillion 1*

Class 2: **The Value of Play** – with Cary Burns (Certified Music Judge). Experts say that play is associated with stress reduction, social and emotional development, and facilitates learning. So, let's play! This class will explore how to use play to ready ourselves for creative music making as well as using play to improve our technical and artistic singing game. *Location: Cotillion 3*

<u>10:10 a.m. – 11:10 a.m.</u>

Class 1: **How the Voice Works** - with Jen Wheaton Forest. Ever wonder how the voice actually works? What does it look like inside that little "box" in your throat? In this course, we will explore the structures in the throat and how they work to make the beautiful sounds that we use every day. *Location: Cotillion 1*

Class 2: **Powerful Performance - What We Can Learn from Other Musical Genres**- with Joe Hunter. An interactive session viewing and discussing a variety of powerful and highly entertaining performances from outside the barbershop arena, done by masters of their craft, with an eye to why such performances are compelling and how we can learn and apply the principles demonstrated. *Location: Cotillion 3*

11:20 a.m. – 12:20 p.m.

Class 1: What does the Story behind the song have to do with SINGING? - with Wendy McCoole (Certified Singing Judge). In this hands-on class you will learn how important it is to understand WHAT we are singing about as it will have a significant impact on your ability to sing as a unit with good vocal quality. We will listen to past quartet champions to understand the evolution of Vocal Expression – a key element of the Singing Category – and discuss tips for understanding the story. *Location: Cotillion 1*

Class 2: **What Shall We Sing in Contest???-** with Kathy Greason. This class explores considerations to weigh in deciding whether to take a song and arrangement to contest, including suitability to your group and suitability for a barbershop contest. *Location: Cotillion 3*
